

The Letter of Introduction

<u>Purpose:</u> (If I do not receive this letter by July 30th, I will assume you have changed your mind and I will remove you from my class list.) I would like to know some basic things about you prior to our first day on this adventure. Keep in mind that AP Biology has college level expectations, so your letter should reflect that level of skill and respect. Some of the things I'd like to know:

- Why are you taking AP Biology?
- How many AP exams have you taken and what where they?
- What other commitments do you have that you feel may impact your AP Biology work?
- What concerns you most about AP Biology?
- Realistically, what score do you expect on the AP exam?
- What are your career plans?
- What topics in Honors Biology did you enjoy most and why?

The Essay

<u>Purpose</u>: I need to see your writing skills. Show me your best word usage, grammar, sentence structure, paragraph construction, research skills, etc. I <u>WILL</u> grade this as college level work. Usually, the sciences use APA format, but in regard to essay writing (such as this) you may use MLA if that is more comfortable for you. Just remember, this is not a creative writing assignment, no conversational speech or creative license.

Instructions:

- A. Read the essay prompt below
- B. Research the topic thoroughly
- C. Write a 700–800-word informative essay.
- D. Submit it to me via email by the due date indicated previously.
- E. Use <u>no fewer</u> than five legitimate, research driven resources, properly cited.
- F. NOTE—EVERYTHING you state, MUST be supported with REAL, SCIENTIFIC evidence
- G. This is NOT an opinion paper; it is a factual, research driven, informational essay
